Mayor Jason Ward opened the meeting at 7:20 p.m. Mr. Truesdell, Mr. Oroke, and Ms. Reed were present. Also present were City Manager Nathan McCommon, Assistant City Manager Jamie Shockley, and City Attorney Michael Kelly.

Discussion on Greystone Subdivision Drainage

Mayor Ward explained the Council's discussions over the past year regarding drainage issues in the Greystone Subdivision, and invited residents who were in attendance to share their thoughts with the Council. A number of residents attended the meeting and voiced concern about being required to move their fences even though they don't believe that action alone will solve the drainage issue. They, instead, expressed some support in creating a benefit district to pay for some of the improvements.

The City Council agreed to have city engineering staff look at what properties should be included in the benefit district, if approved by the voters, and would work on what the process would be to create that benefit district. In the meantime, the City Council requested that the property owners contact the developer of the property and see if there is any interest in contributing to correcting the drainage issues.

Mayor Ward requested to have this on the agenda to revisit the issue at the next City Council meeting on September 6.
